

Technology Guidelines and Writing Practice



iPad Rules:

- 1) Students will be assigned an iPad number, and must maintain the use of the same iPad all year.
- 2) Students must understand that they are responsible for the iPad they are using, and will be given a \$500 obligation if the iPad is broken/lost while in their possession.
- 3) iPads NEVER leave the classroom unless the teacher's lesson requires it. Please do not send students out to the hallway/courtyard/Media Center/etc. with an iPad without supervision.
- 4) If there is an issue with an iPad, please notify teacher immediately.
- 5) Students are not allowed to change any settings on the iPad (immediate referral), take pictures of other students without that student's permission, upload pictures (unless as an assignment) to a social media site, or use the iPad for any non-academic purposes.
- 6) In case of any of the above, appropriate discipline steps will be taken and the entire iPad cart must be reimaged.
- 7) The iPad cart locked at all times! STUDENTS SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE ROOM (AND NO NEW STUDENTS ALLOWED TO ENTER THE ROOM) UNTIL ALL IPADS ARE ACCOUNTED FOR.
- 8) iPads will not be used to play games.
- 9) Students are expected to use EDMODO regularly.
- 10) iPad usage is a privilege, and can be revoked at any time.
